### **Line up Instructions:**

- Line up begins at 6:30 pm on Haddon Avenue between McMillan's Bakery and Stratford Avenue NOTE: Haddon Avenue will shut down at 6:45 pm, so try to be early.
- ★ The parade will begin promptly at 7:30 pm − It starts at Albertson Avenue and ends at Maple Avenue.
- **Parade leaders** will line up on Haddon Avenue between French Avenue and Franco's Place.
- All walking costumed participants (Adults and Juveniles)
  will line up in front of Cook's Liquors by Group Numbers (1, 2 or 3) which are written on the Registration Number Cards.
- **Floats** will line up on Strawbridge Avenue.
- Organizations/Groups, Bands and Entertainers should report to the Parade Chair (standing at the corner of French and Haddon Aves) to get their line up spots.
- All Vehicles in the parade will line up on Haddon between Strawbridge and Stratford Avenues. See the Parade Chair upon arrival for your lineup position.

- ## All registrants will be judged. Judges will circulate through the entire parade route.
- ## Parade Registration Number Cards must be worn and clearly visible
- ## Due to safety concerns there is to be no throwing of candy or other items along the parade route.
